Dear St. Paul's Family,

Every fall we find ourselves at the beginning of another Annual Commitment Campaign. Each year, this invites a moment of reflection and renewal, as we contemplate our individual and collective contributions to the life and mission of St. Paul's. This year, our campaign committee connected this moment to the experience of the disciples in Luke 5:4-6::

Yet if you say so, I will let down the nets.' When they had done this, they caught so many fish that their nets were beginning to break."

It's not about the absence of fish (which, as any who have fished with me can attest, is a fairly ordinary occurrence), but the presence of abundance when we respond to a deeper call. At St. Paul's, we are living this story. We are engaged in our everyday tasks, our worship, our service to our community, grounded in the richness of the rituals that shape us. Stewardship is our collective response to this invitation. It's not merely about financial contributions but a commitment to exploring the depths of our faith, talents, and resources in concrete ways that connect our commitments with others. It's about recognizing that every act, every gift, is a step into deeper waters, revealing the abundance that God shares with us.

I invite you to reflect: How can we, as individuals and a community, continue our ordinary work with an extraordinary depth of commitment and generosity? How can we answer Jesus' call to cast our nets deeper, to explore the boundless generosity that God is sharing with us?
